MISSION DIRECTOR'S COLUMN HOW I BECAME A PRIEST?



At times people had asked me how I became a priest. I tell them that I did not experience any supernatural call. My family did not compel me to become a priest.

So let me share what made me a priest. My family and society loved and respected priests. Pastor was the top most

person in status. Parishioners talk about the priest with high esteem. Children were not allowed to criticize the priest. Adults made only positive remarks on priests in front of children. If they prepare any special food, they used to share it with their pastor. I used to deliver it from my home to the rectory.

My family had a great desire that I become a priest. They encouraged me to pray to God that I be made a priest. They themselves prayed that one from the family become a priest. They encouraged me to attend daily mass and to assist as an alter boy.

Priests were my heroes. I used to talk about them and tried to imitate them. I wanted to be like them. They loved me and encouraged me. I used to subscribe and read periodicals that promote vocation to priesthood. My teachers had high esteem for priesthood and told in the class that I would be a good candidate for priesthood.

I attended Religious Education Classes and Pious Associations. I felt that I had a great passion to work for the church and the community. I studied with the goal of getting admission in the seminary. I had correspondence with a vocation promoter. I attended vocation seminars that dealt with vocation to all types of life including family life. When I was considering to join the seminary, my family asked me to be careful in making such a decision because of the life-long commitment. During my seminary life, I got encouragement from my family, relatives, friends, priests, and the community.

Thanks to God, during my last 25 years as a priest, I never regretted on my decision to become a priest. I enjoyed my ministry even during my hard times. Jesus is my role model in all aspects of my life as a chaplain, social worker, media person, leader, teacher, and priest.

My present assignment as mission director of Knanaya Mission - Chicago is the most challenging in my past 25 years of priesthood. Considering the challenges Jesus had and his sacrifices, mine is nothing. Jesus gives me strength and guidance. I invite you all to thank the Lord for what I am. I am grateful to God for allowing me to serve you at this difficult time. I pray for all of you.

JUBILERIAN FR. ABRAHAM MUTHOLATH

As we are celebrating the 25th anniversary of the ordination of our mission director Rev. Fr. Abraham Mutholath, we are presenting here his biography.

GEORGE THOTTAPURAM

BACKGROUND AND EARLY EDU-CATION: Fr. Abraham Mutholath was born in October 1954 in Mutholath family at Cherpunkal, Kottayam District, in India. His parents are M.C. Chacko and Achamma. He has one brother and five sisters. All of them, except Sr. Saly, are now in California with their families. Sr. Saly, a member of Visitation Congregation is a nurse in Switzerland and superior of the convent.

After completing tenth grade from St. Mary's High School, Kidangoor, Abraham joined Minor Seminary at S. H. Mount, Kottayam for a three-year course along with Pre-degree course at C.M.S. College. His Major Seminary Course was in St. Joseph's Pontifical Seminary Aluva from 1974 to December 1980. Bro. Abraham published his first book "Ningalkkum Nethavakam" (You Too Can be a Leader) while he was a student in the seminary.

Abraham was ordained a priest on December 21, 1980 by Mar Kuriakose Kunnacherry, Bishop of Kottayam on his Sacerdotal Silver Jubilee Day.

REFORMS IN VELIYANAD: The first assignment of Fr. Abraham was as assistant vicar at St. Stephen's Church Uzhavoor from January 1981. During his assignment there, he revived the Knanaya Catholic Youth League (KCYL) unit of Uzhavoor parish. KCYL Uzhavoor unit won the best unit trophy from the diocese that year. Fr. Abraham started writing a series of articles on priestly leadership that was published regularly in *Apna Des*, the diocesan periodical.

Fr. Abraham was vicar (pastor) at St. Michael's Church at Veliyanad from 1982 to 1985. During that period he organized neighborhood groups of parishioners called *Kudumba Sammelanam* according to the principles of Basic Christian Communities. At that time it was an innovative approach to parish ministry and was successful in coordinating the parishioners who are scattered allover Kuttanad. He also organized four batches of Charis-

matic Retreat for the spiritual renewal of parishioners and other Christians in the area. He also conducted youth seminars on Sundays and won diocesan trophies for best KCYL unit and best Sunday school for Veliyanad parish.

Fr. Abraham gave leadership in constructing the Visitation Convent in Veliyanad and established a nursery school and primary school close to the parish. He was the organizer and first president of Veliyanad YMCA.

WRITER AND ADMINISTRATOR: Bishop Mar Kuriakose Kunnacherry transferred Fr. Abraham Mutholath in 1985 from Veliyanad to Pachira parish as vicar. At the same time bishop appointed him as chief editor of diocesan periodicals: Apna Des and Sacred Heart Monthly. He was also assigned as the Manager of Catholic Mission Press and Jyothi Book House. Until that time these diocesan periodicals and institutions were running at a loss and the diocese had to give subsidy to run them. Within a short time, Fr. Abraham improved the quality of these and made them economically self-reliant.

Fr. Mutholath was the chief editor of the souvenir published during the Platinum Jubilee Celebrations of the Diocese of Kottayam. That souvenir is a historical document of the diocese and its various institutions.

Fr. Abraham Mutholath published four Malayalam books: (1) *Ningalkkum Nethavakam* (You Too Can Be a Leader) had three editions. (2) *Neethruthwa Pariseelanam* (Leadership Training) had two editions. (3) *Bible Games* had two editions. and (4) *Vaidika Nethruthwam Innu Nale* (Priestly Leadership - Today Tomorrow).

STUDIES IN THE UNITED STATES: Fr. Abraham Mutholath went to Los Angeles in November 1987 for higher studies in Communications. He studied journalism and gained Master of Arts in Communication (TV Production) from Loyola Marymount University, Los Angeles.

During this time Fr. Abra-

ham was resident priest at St. Jerome Church in Los Angeles, Chaplain of Knights of Columbus in Westchester, Spiritual Director of Kerala Catholic Association of Los Angeles, initiator of Knanaya Catholic Congress of Los Angeles (KCCLA) and Knanaya Catholic Youth League of Los Angeles KCYLLA). He was also actively involved in the formation and drafting of constitution of Knanaya Catholic Congress of North America (KCCNA).

While in the United States, Fr. Mutholath wrote a satirical novel on the life of Kerala immigrants in the United States titled, "Annammacheduthy Americayil" that was serialized in *Apna Des.* Mr. Raju Joseph Paralel produced a Malayalam film titled "Dollar" based on that novel. Fr. Abraham Mutholath was the screenplay writer of the movie.

DIRECTOR OF PASTORAL CENTER: When Fr. Mutholath returned to India in November 1992, Bishop Kunnacherry appointed him as the diocesan chaplain of Knanaya Catholic Youth League (KCYL), director of Communication Media and Contact Person for Diaspora Ministry. He was also the chief editor of the souvenir published in commemoration of the Episcopal Silver Jubilee Celebrations of Bishop Mar Kuriakose Kunnacherry.

As diocesan chaplain of KCYL, he traveled the main cities of the Untied States to establish KCYL units in the United States. This led to the formation of KCYLNA (KCYL North America). He also attended KCYLNA conventions held in the United States. He organized KCYL International Camps at Chaithanya Pastoral Center, Kottayam.

As the director of Communication Media, Fr. Mutholath offered classes on Me-

dia as visiting professor at Madnaha Institute of Theology at Thellakom, St. Thomas Apostolic Seminary Vadavathoor, and Mahathma Gandhi University in Kottayam. He produced and directed many



tele-films on social issues.

In 1994, Bishop Kuriakose Kunnacherry appointed Fr. Mutholath as the director of Chaithanya at Thellakom. Fr. Mutholath was the first resident director of Chaithanya

after it was transferred in the newly constructed building in Thellakom. He managed to build up Chaithanya as a prestigious institution in India. He started an agricultural nursery also at Chaithanya premises.

As Contact Person of Diaspora Ministry, Fr. Mutholath collected the census of all Knanaya Catholics living outside Kerala and India and prepared a computerized database. He stared a computerized marriage bureau at Chaithanya that became a great success. He also started a website for the Diocese of Kottayam and a free Internet Marriage Bureau that can be accessed from anywhere in the world.

In 1995, Bishop Kunnacherry gave him additional charge as the secretary of Kottayam Social Service Society (KSSS). Fr. Mutholath adopted developmental approach in social work. He introduced in the parishes self-help groups for women, widows, senior citizens, unmarried and unemployed girls, students from economically weak families, and of physically and mentally handicapped. He encouraged the groups to take up collective actions for their development and to start income generation programs and microcredit union for their self-reliance. He appointed animators in each parish and coordinators for each program and for each forane. He also introduced Village Development Groups in parishes to implement and monitor the social service activities of each village. The Community Based Rehabilitation Program for the Physically and Mentally Retarded became a great success. Fr. Abraham could give job to many unemployed housewives and to give a renewed lifestyle for many low-income people.

Bishop Kunnacherry later appointed him as the director of Caritas Ayurvedic Hospital. He was the first director of the hospital and has been involved in the establishment of this institution.

BACK TO THE UNITED STATES: Bishop Kunnacherry assigned Fr. Abraham to serve in the United States as Chaplain at Robert F. Kennedy Medical Center in Hawthorne, Los Angeles and to take care of the pastoral needs of the Knanaya Catholics in Los Angeles. So he reached Los Angeles in December 2000 and served Kerala Catholic Community and Knanaya Catholic Community in Los Angeles and lived at St. Jerome Church in Los Angeles until he left to Chicago on February 15, 2003.

Fr. Abraham Mutholath also attended Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) Residency Program at UCLA Medical Center from September 2001 to August 2002 and has successfully completed the required four units of CPE.

Fr. Mutholath also took initiative in the establishment of Visitation Convent in Los Angeles by bringing four sisters from Kottayam. He has also helped in the establishment of St. Joseph's Convent in West Covina, Los Angeles.

Because of his passion to help the less fortunate in the society, Fr. Abraham Mutholath established Agape Movement, a non-profit corporation in the United States primarily to support the social service and pastoral activities of the Archdiocese of Kottayam. It is registered in California and Illinois. He contributes a substantial amount from his income through Agape Movement.

VICAR GENERAL: His Excellency Mar Jacob Angadiath, the bishop of St. Thomas Syro-Malabar Catholic Diocese of Chicago appointed Fr. Mutholath on October 3, 2001 as the Syncellus (Vicar

General) of the Eparchy. At the request of the bishop, Fr. Mutholath has moved from Los Angeles to Chicago.

After reaching Chicago on February 16, 2003, Fr. Abraham started serving as chaplain at Our Lady of Resurrection Hospital in Chicago. He has designed and maintains the following websites: kottayamad.org

(Official Website of the Archdiocese of Kottayam), knanayacatholics.com (Website of Knanaya Catholic Community with free marriage bureau), olvchicago.org (Website of Our Lady of Victory Parish and School with Sunday Bulletin), agapemovement.org (Website of Agape Movement, a non-profit corporation), mutholath.com (Website of Mutholath family), eucharistichomeshrines.org (Website of Eucharistic Home Shrines that promotes devotion to the Blessed Sacrament), knanayamission.org (Website of Knanaya Catholic Missions in North America), chicgoboychoir.org (Website of Chicago Boy Choir), and knanaya yahoo group (Internet discussion forum of Knanaya Community).

MISSION DIRECTOR OF CHICAGO Bishop Mar Jacob Angadiath gave additional charge as the director of Knanaya Catholic Mission in Chicago with effect from July 1, 2004. As director of the mission, he has made the mission very active by starting regular Saturday evening Masses, strengthening Religious Education Schools, celebrating solemn feasts of saints, establishing pious associations and various ministries for children and youth.

JUBILEE CELEBRATION IN INDIA: Fr. Mutholath is celebrating his jubilee in his home village Cherpunkal on January 2, 2006. The functions include Holy Mass at 2:00 P.M. and dedicating Agape Center at Cherpunkal to the social service department of the Archdiocese of Kottayam. Agape Center in Cherpunkal is a social service center that trains 26 physically and mentally challenged children and youth. Since there are many applicants, the new building will be able to accommodate more people. This center is fully financed by the earnings of Fr. Mutholath. We congratulate Fr. Mutholath for this wonderful example and wish him all best during his jubilee season.




