

Ms. Pell was an aspiring gymnast at Victor J. Andrew High School in Tinley Park. At the age of 16, on December 29th, 1980 in the middle of an exercise routine she unexpectedly met with an accident rendering her permanently paralyzed. Although this one rather cruel act resulted in the use of a wheelchair for the rest of her life and totally dependent on other assistance such as a service dog to do even the routine things like pressing an elevator button which we all take for granted, she did not give up and trusted her faith. Luckily, she was gifted with other options and a way to see a new life. Rather than giving into the obvious, she overcame her shortcoming and leads a "normal" life by engaging and dedicating herself to

God almighty. Ms. Pell is a true inspiration to anybody who comes in contact with her.

Ms. Pell leads an active life and is a student at Moraine Valley Community College, is a leading vocalist at St. Francis of Assisi parish in Orland Park and engages herself by sharing in the celebration of life and the glorious opportunities that we are blessed with.

So come and join in a lively conversation about overcoming different adversities we face in real life with Ms. Pell and meet her trusted companion, a Black Labrador named Flame.






