## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

### The Devine Mercy Devotion

My dear Knanaya Sisters and Brothers:

The Universal Catholic Church observes Sunday after Easter as Devine Mercy Sunday. This Devotion has its origin from a young Polish nun St. Sister Faustyna Kowalska who lived from 1905 to 1938. Sr. Faustina had a vision on February 22, 1931 with rays of mercy streaming from the areas of Jesus' Heart. He told her to paint this vision with the inscription "Jesus, I trust in You!" He also ordered her to write a diary so others would learn to trust in him. In a series of revelations, Jesus taught her that His Mercy is unlimited and available even to the greatest sinners.

The focus of Devine Mercy Devotion is on the Mercy of God. Its basis is the words of Jesus: *Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and you shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you (Mathew 7:7)*. God assures that He will not turn away any one who seeks God's mercy. However, we have to show mercy to others as expressed in the Lord's Prayer: *"Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us."* (Mathew 6:12).

Jesus taught us the parable of a king who wished to settle accounts with his servants (Mathew 18:23-35). The king was generous to forgive 10,000 talents to his servant who fell at his knees pleading for mercy. This lucky man was cruel to his fellow servant who knelt and pleaded for some time to repay the 100 denarii he owed. He put that fellow servant in prison until he would pay back the money. Based on the report of other fellow servants the king punished the servant whom he had forgiven earlier. Therefore, Jesus wants acts of mercy from us in dealing with others when we seek the mercy of God.

Jesus himself showed this mercy even when he was nailed to the cross and at the extreme level of his suffering on the cross. Our acts of mercy shall start from our family to our community, work place, and the world at large. Many Christians have put this teaching into practice. That is why we see great acts of mercy, love, and compassion from the followers of Jesus Christ.

### Spotlight

**God and people appreciate us on not what we have earned for ourselves, but on what good we have done for others.**



There are corporal and spiritual works of mercy. The corporal works of mercy include: Feed the hungry, Give drink to the thirsty, Clothe the naked, Shelter the homeless, Comfort the prisoners, Visit the sick, and Bury the dead. The spiritual works of mercy are: Teach the ignorant, Pray for the living and dead, Correct sinners, Counsel those in doubt, Console the sorrowful, Bear wrongs patiently, and Forgive wrongs willingly. When we do these, we become the children of God and true followers of Jesus.

Sr. Faustyna Kowalska's original first name was Helena. She was born on August 25, 1905 in Glogowiec, Poland; the third of ten children. At the age of seven, she heard the voice of God calling her to religious life. After her primary education, Helena started domestic work to support her large family. In 1924, Helena saw a vision of the scourged Christ who calls her to religious life. She went to Warsaw in search for a convent, and she worked to support herself. The Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy accepted Helena to their congregation. However, one month later she left for a stricter community. Helena received her religious habit and her religious name Maria Faustina on April 30, 1926. During her novitiate in 1927, she felt spiritual darkness. On Good Friday, April 16, 1928 a flame of Devine Love engulfed her.

After her vision of Devine Mercy on February 22, 1931, Sr. Faustina went to Vilnius on May 25, 1933 where she received many mystical experiences from Fr. Michael Sopocko, a wise spiritual director. She died on October 5, 1938. By the time of her death, devotion to The Devine Mercy had begun to spread throughout Eastern Europe. It helped to sustain the faithful during the terrible suffering of World War II.

A Polish Marian priest Fr. Joseph Jarzebowski, who was trying to flee from war-torn Poland in July 1940, prayed to the Merciful Savior to help him escape, vowing to spend his life spreading the Devine Mercy Message. The Congregation of Marians of the Immaculate Conception spread The Devine Mercy Message all over the world.

Pope John Paul II canonized Sr. Faustina on the Sunday after Easter in April 2000. Pope also established the Sunday after Easter as the Devine Mercy Sunday worldwide. Let us seek the mercy of the Lord by showing mercy and reciting the Devine Mercy Chaplet.
