Pastor's Message



What a Wonderful Performance!

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

I am sure all of us who have attended the Religious Education Festival 2011 of our both Knanaya Catholic Parishes held on March 26th at Maine East High School Auditorium, or watched that on the internet, are very much taken up by the performance of all involved in the program. I would like to comment on some of the highlights of the festival.

Many appreciated that we started the program exactly at 6:00 P.M. as he had announced. We need to keep up that in all our future functions. Keeping announced schedule saves the valuable time of all and helps us to finish the program on time. The coordinators arranged all the dances and skits with only 15 seconds of transition time. That also was impressive to all. It saved lot of time of the participants and kept the audience curious without any boring break. People who have been watching on the internet at www.knanayavoice.com also felt that the timing was professional.

All our theatric presentations were message oriented and catechetical. As Vicar General Msgr. George Madathiparambil mentioned in his speech, with the Religious Education Festival, we have revolutionized the concept of Indian dance by adapting them to Christian format. All our five-hour programs were Christian. This year our teachers spent more time to explain to the performers the content and message of what they were performing. Even the viewers had a good chance to reflect on the songs, actions, visuals, and their message. They were catechetical because these skits and dances communicated to the performers and audience the stories that they were not fully aware on the Bible and Knanaya Community.

As some one remarked, **this is world record in the number of onstage performers.** We had altogether 768 people, including 635 students and 133 teachers all performing the best possible way they could. Besides, we had many working behind the curtain. This collective effort allowed those involved to study the Bible and the history of the Knanaya

Community. Usually only the so-called talented and trained children were given chance on the stage. Since we insist that all students and teachers come on stage, all of them got chance to develop their talents and skills appropriate to their age.

Our theme for the festival was different from past years and relevant to the time. We could celebrate the 10th anniversary of St. Thomas Syro-Malabar Catholic Diocese of Chicago and the 100th anniversary of the Archdiocese of Kottayam. This is the first time we are presenting the Knanaya history beyond the settlement at Kodungalloor. So the skit on the community was informative and attractive. "God's Call and Selection of Humanity" was an appropriate theme because we are part of God's Call to human life and Catholic Faith. Besides, this call, we will be selected to heaven at the final judgment based on our good deeds for others in this world. This festival gave many of us the right direction during the time of lent.

We made maximum use of computerized technology that made more visual impact. This is the first time we have used so much visuals and sound effects along with the acting. They helped us to move us to a higher level of enjoyment and reflection. Thanks to those worked for it.

There was more unification of both parishes. This was our first festival after the establishment of St. Mary's Church. We felt feeling as one community rather than a divided one. We need to promote more combined programs in the future also.

I would like to express again my great appreciation to our Religious Education Students, teachers, and parents of both schools for their outstanding performance and cooperation. Thanks to our DREs: Johny Thekkeparambil, Saji Poothrukayil, Sabu Mutholam and Maneesh Kaimoolayil. Dance choreographers including Mrs. Lalu Palamattom did a wonderful service. The skit on Knanaya Community by Jain Makil and team, and the Biblical presentation prepared by Sibi Alumparambil and Johny Thekkeparambil are outstanding. Benny Thomas, Sunny Joseph, Antony and Lalichen Alumparambil, Saji Malithuruthel, Danny Chakkiyath and Pauly Vathikalam did the audio pre-production and sound system during the performance. Shiju Cheiyathil, Siby Jacob, Saji Panayaparambil, and Jose Thoompanal did the special effects. 
