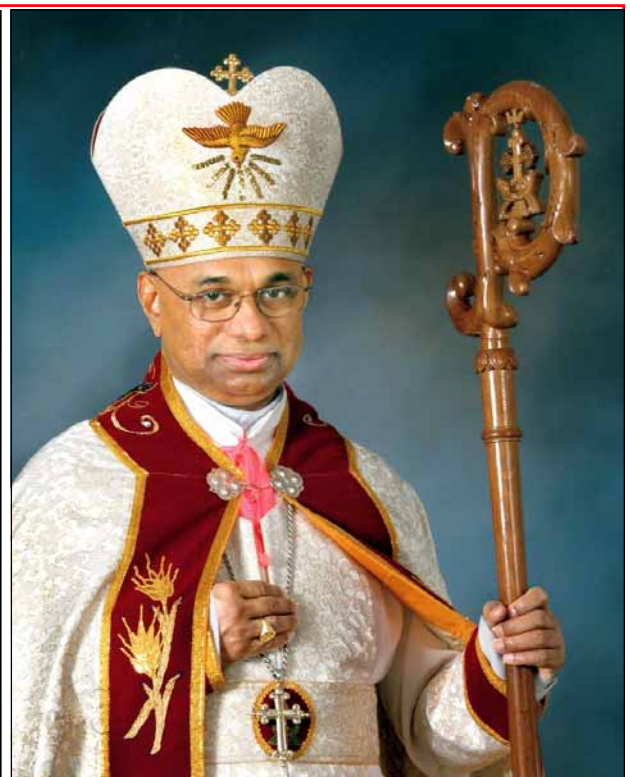

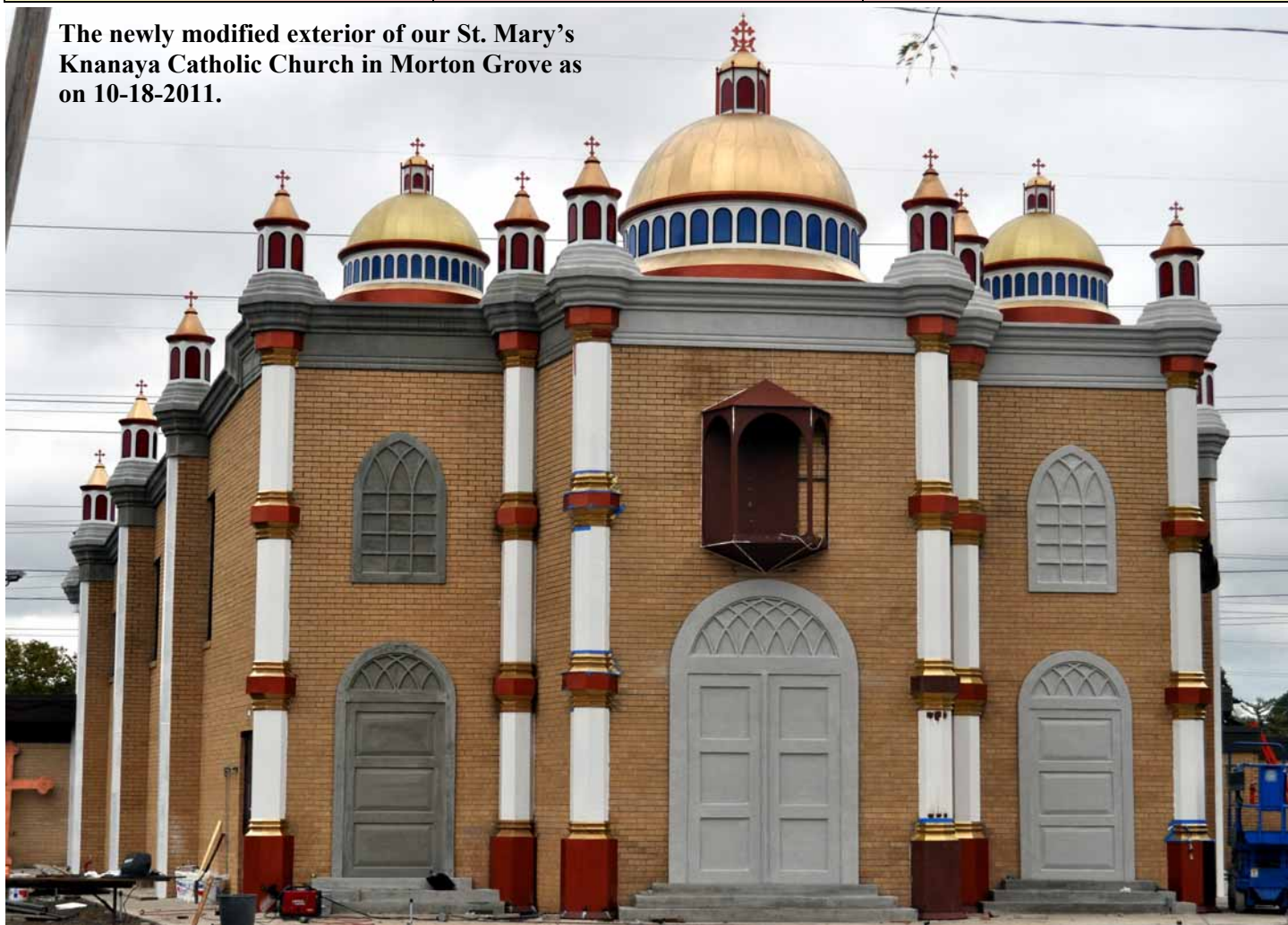

Circular of the Major Archbishop on Mission Fund

Circular Letter

Syro-Malabar Mission Fund

GEORGE ALENCHERRY, the Major Archbishop of the Syro-Malabar Church, to the Archbishops, Bishops, Priests, Men and Women Religious and Lay faithful of the Syro-Malabar Church, Praise be to Jesus Christ!

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

The Syro-Malabar Church that is ever obliged "to witness Christ unto the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8), is active in her ministry of building up of the Church. It is a flourishing Individual Church with 29 eparchies in India and abroad. The Syro-Malabar Church that is deeply rooted in the soil of Kerala, thanks to the evangelization of St. Thomas, has spread extensively in the whole of India and also to the continents of Australia, America, Africa, Asia and Europe. As you are aware, there are 10 mission eparchies outside the proper territory, such as Chanda, Ujjain, Satna, Bijnor, Rajkot, Ghorakhpur, Jagdalpur, Adilabad, Sagar and Kalyan.

It is the fundamental responsibility of the Mother Church to help the mission eparchies spiritually and financially. Keeping this goal in mind, the Syro-Malabar Synod has formed an association titled 'The Association of Supporters of the Syro-Malabar Mission' (A. S. S. M), for those who desire to support the mission eparchies spiritually and financially. Through this, the Synod hopes to bring all the families of the Syro Malabar Church into constant contact and communion with the Mother Church.

The primary goal of this association is to create missionary awareness in the hearts of the Syro-Malabar faithful. The association will publish a News Bulletin in 3 volumes annually. I request the sincere co-operation of all the priests, religious, families and institutions for the success of this mission endeavour. The association offers an opportunity for all families and Institutes of Consecrated Life to take part in the activities of the association spiritually and financially. Therefore, I earnestly request that every family may contribute a sum of Rs. 200, and each Religious Congregation and other Institutions Rs. 500 annually for the realization of the goals of this association.

In order to give efficient leadership to the diverse activities of the association, I hereby appoint, with the consent of the Synod, Mar Gregory Karotemprel CMI, the Bishop Emeritus of the Eparchy of Rajkot and former Chairman of the Commission for the Evangelization and Pastoral Care of Migrants, as the Director of the association. There will be a lay representative from each eparchy for the effective functioning of the association. The governing body consisting of the Director and lay representa-

tives will take decisions for the association. The details regarding the fund received and the areas where it is distributed will be circulated in the news bulletin.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, helping the communities that are economically backward has been a holy tradition of the Church down the ages, from the time of first Christian communities. St. Paul in his letter to the Romans whole heartedly congratulated those communities in Macedonia and Achaia that shared their resources with the poor among the saints in Jerusalem (Rom 15, 26). How noble is the ecclesial vision of St. Paul: "You are the body of Christ and individually members of it"! (1Cor 12, 27). "If one part of the body suffers, all the other parts suffer with it; if one part is praised, all the other parts share its happiness" (1Cor 12, 26). Let us therefore, develop an ecclesial spirituality that will wipe away the tears of those who weep, help the downtrodden and relieve the pain of those in distress. This association is to be viewed as the external realization of the incessant inner call of the Church for the preferential love for the poor. May we be enabled to respond with our lives to the exhortation of St. Paul, "you should always remember the poor" (Gal 2,10). The world will then realize that "the joy and hope, the grief and anguish of the men of our time, especially of those who are poor or afflicted in any way, are the joy and hope, the grief and anguish of the followers of Christ as well (GS 1).

YOUTH CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

CHAPTER TWO: God Approaches Us Men

Q7: Why did God have to show himself in order for us to be know what he is like?

A7: Man can know by reason that God exists, but not what God is really like. Yet because God would very much like to be known, he has revealed himself.

God did not have to reveal himself to us. But he did it out of love. Just as in human love one can know something about the beloved person only if he opens his heart to us, so too we know something about God's inmost thoughts only because the eternal and mysterious God has opened himself to us out of love. From creation on, through the patriarchs and the prophets down to definitive REVELATION in his Son Jesus Christ, God has spoken again and again to mankind. In him he has poured out his heart to us and made his inmost being visible for us.

Q8: How does God reveal himself in the Old Testament?

A8: God shows himself in the OLD TESTAMENT as God, who created the world out of love and remains faithful to men even when they have fallen away from him into sin.

God makes it possible to experience him in history: With Noah he establishes a covenant to save all living things. He calls Abraham so as to make him "the father of a multitude of nations" (Gen 17:5b) and to bless "all families of the earth" in him (Gen 12:3b). The people Israel, sprung from Abraham, becomes his special possession. To Moses he introduces himself by name. His mysterious name יְהוָה, usually transcribed Yahweh, means "I AM WHO I AM" (Ex3:14). He frees Israel from slavery in Egypt, establishes a covenant with them on Sinai, and through Moses gives them the Law. Again and again, God sends prophets to his people to call them to conversion and

to the renewal of the covenant. The prophets proclaim that God will establish a new and everlasting covenant, which will bring about a radical renewal and definitive redemption. This covenant will be open to all human beings.

Q9: What does God show us about himself when he sends his Son to us?

A9: God shows us in Jesus Christ the full depth of his merciful love.

Through Jesus Christ the invisible God becomes visible. He becomes a man like us. This shows us how far God's love goes: He bears our whole burden. He walks every path with us. He is there in our abandonment, our sufferings, and our fear of death. He is there when we can go no farther, so as to open for us the door leading into life.
